Step 5: Send Your Smile

- Ask your parents to send the photo of you holding up your self-portrait to kidsclub@childhouses.org. Tell us your first name, how old you are, where you're from, and something funny about yourself. What's a really silly thing about you? We are going to post that picture on our Kids Club Gallery to show the world how many kids are spreading the smiles for Syria.

Step 6: Help Syrian Children

- Talk to your parents about making a small donation to Child Houses to support children in Syria. Explain that the money will help provide things like hearing aids and crutches to children who need them.
